✓ DO THIS:

MORNING TIME

During breakfast, talk with your child about what it means to love someone. What are ways you can show someone you love them today?

DRIVING TIME

As you drive, when you see a stop sign or stop at a red light, talk about how God's love for you is never-ending. God will never stop loving you.

CUDDLE TIME

Pray with your child "God, teach us to love others as you love us. Even when someone hurts our feelings help us to forgive and love them. Help us to be full of your love so we may love others."

BATH TIME

As you wash your body, point out the heart. Explain that Jesus loves you so much that He put people in your life who love you and whom you can love. Who are some of those people?
